You get to choose the lottery that you want to play. For example, if you choose the black color and lottery 3, and we draw a black ball, you will win 10 rand, otherwise you will win 3.

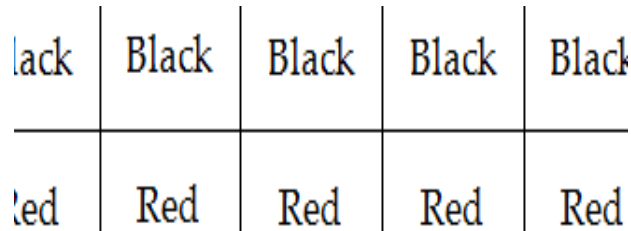

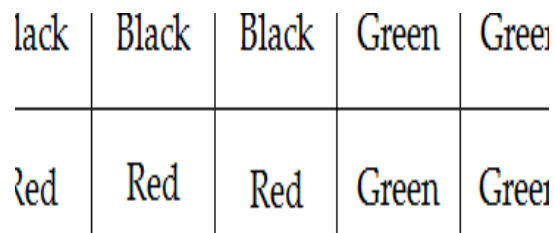

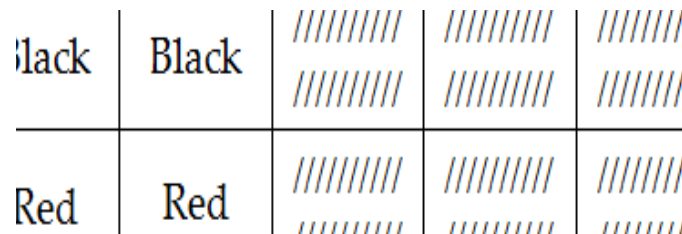
