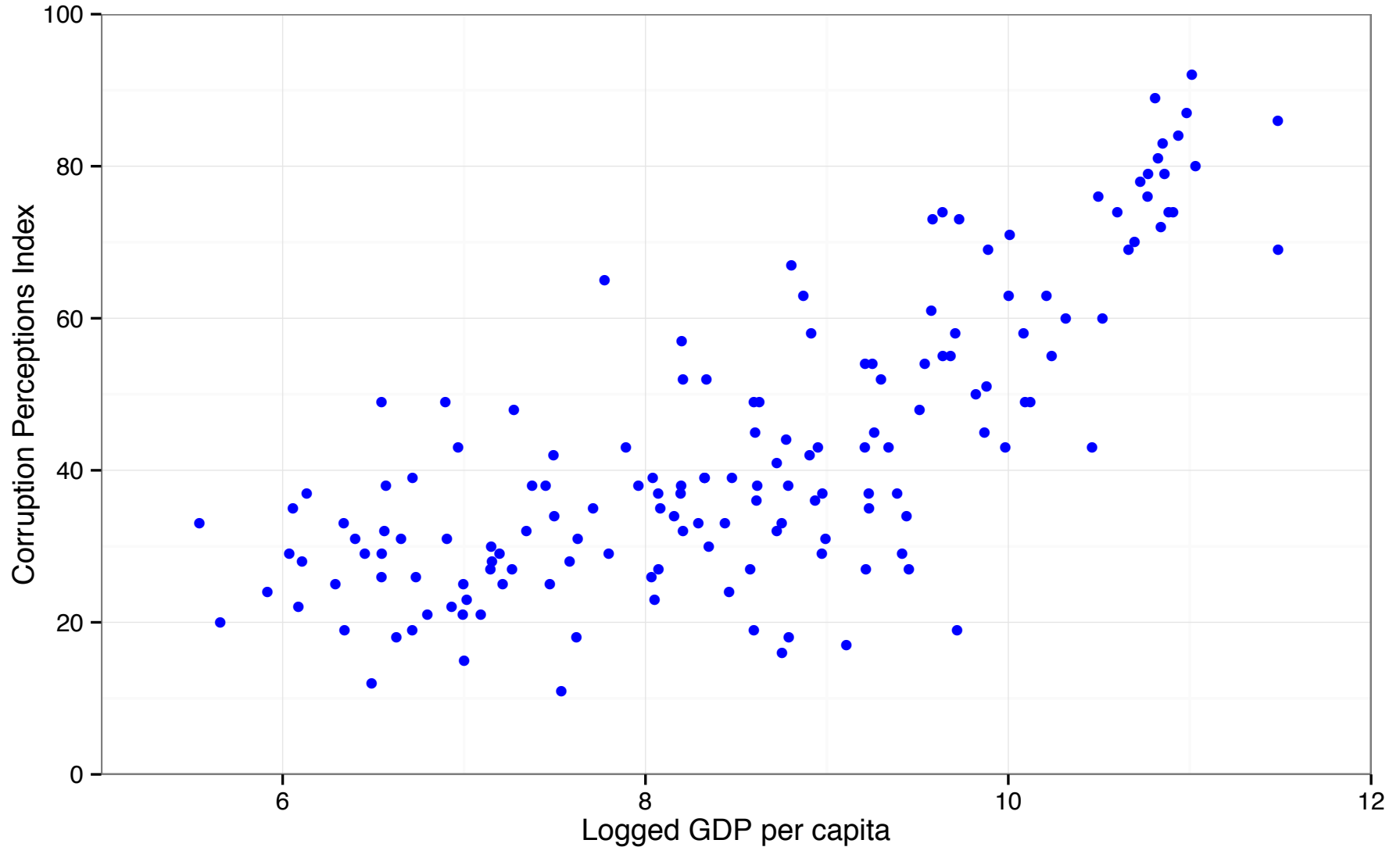

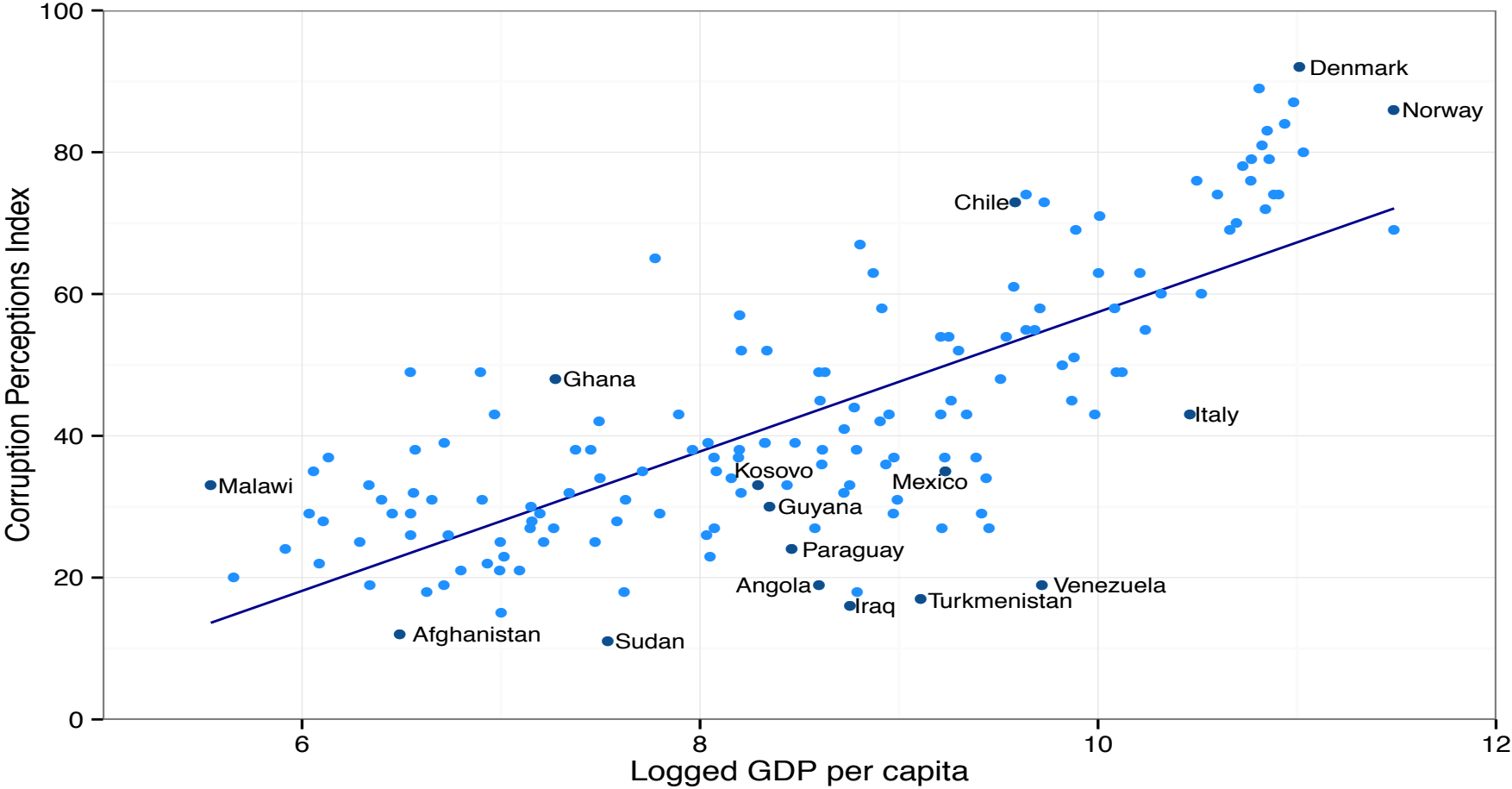
Perceptions of Corruption and Logged GDP Per Capita (2014), 158 Countries

- Which countries are much more corrupt than their level of economic development predicts, thereby giving them the most room to be “nudged” to make progress quickly?

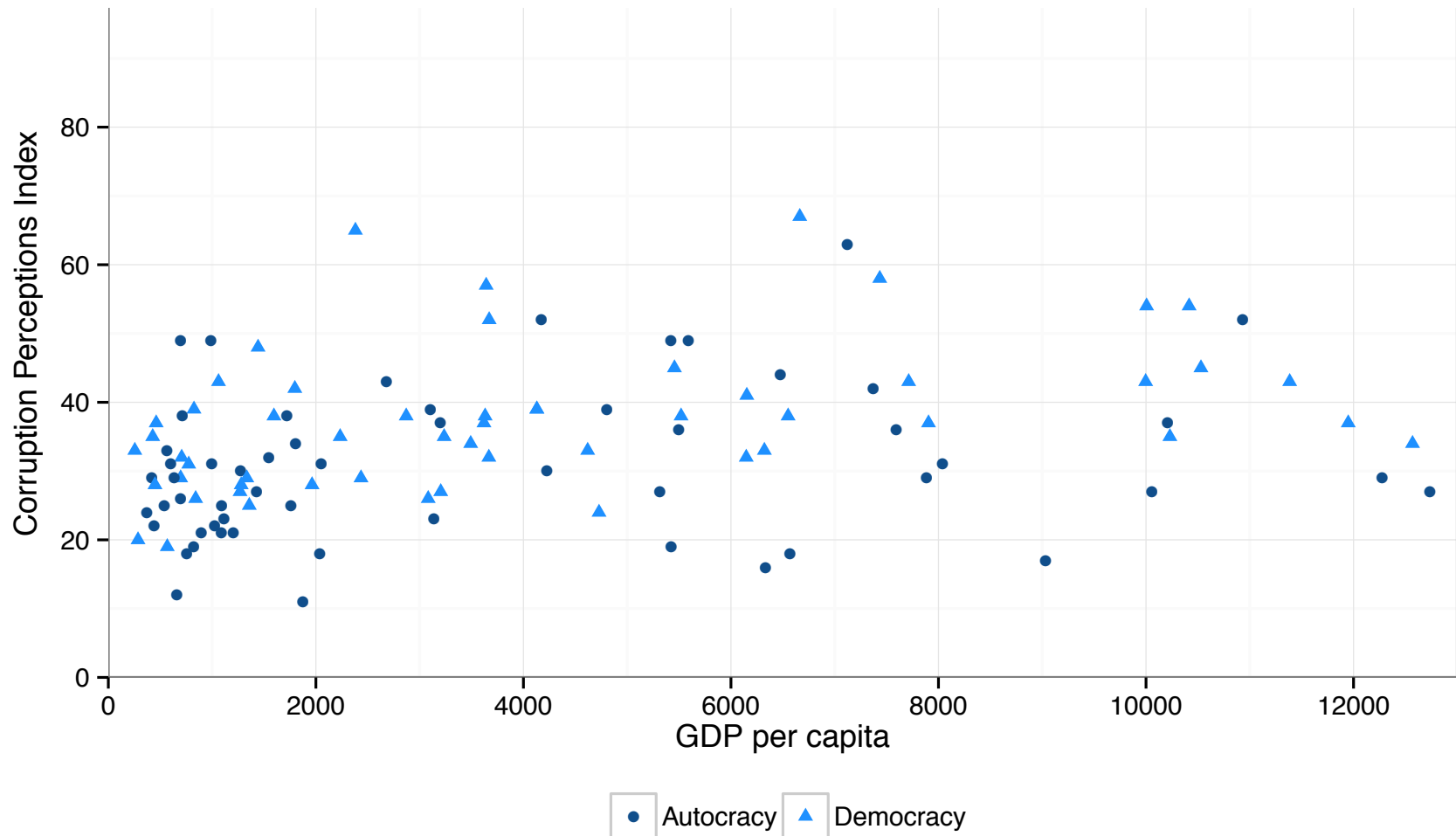
Perceptions of Corruption and Logged GDP Per Capita (2014), 158 Countries, Outliers Labeled

Key Question 4

- How can displacement effects be anticipated and then identified and remediated so that “solutions” do not simply produce new problems?

Key Question 6

- Would more and better resources to the courts make corruption enforcement more predictable, and thereby contribute to a reduction of overall levels?
